Agenda Item: Consider Approval for Fencing RFP 2425-006 Amendment of Authorized Amount		
<p>Summary:</p> <p>At the December 2024 Board meeting, the Fencing RFP 2425-006 was awarded to Anderson Fence.</p> <p>After the award, the district did site visits to two (2) local districts that Anderson had completed fencing projects. These site visits were to determine what fencing standards would best fit Terrell ISD including height of fences, placement, automation options, entry gates and egress gates needed at each campus.</p> <p>On February 24, 2025, the board approved the fencing project authorized amount not to exceed \$750,000.</p> <p>All campuses are substantially complete with the exception of Terrell High School. The district is requesting an increase in order to make an adjustment for Terrell High School and allow for any final unforeseen adjustments that may be needed at other campuses.</p> <p>The district is requesting approval for an increase of \$75,000 for a total not to exceed the amount of \$825,000.</p>
