SUMMATIVE FOUR-YEAR COHORT GRAUDUATION RATE GOAL:

The four-year cohort graduation rate will continue to increase each year, placing the district among the top 20% of districts in Oregon by 2020.

SUMMATIVE ACADEMIC ACHIVEMENT GOAL:

Student achievement levels in English/Language Arts and Mathematics will increase across all grades and all levels, and overall achievement will place the district and each of the district's schools among the top 20% of comparison districts & schools and above the state average by 2020.
