



### **ParentSquare**

Jarrell ISD uses ParentSquare for teacher-to-parent communication. ParentSquare is designed to keep parents informed and facilitate participation at school. It provides a safe way for teachers and parents/guardians to communicate.

Last year, we used ClassTag as our teacher-to-parent communication tool. However, after the feedback we received, it was clear parents wanted a change. We will now use ParentSquare. It offers a streamlined and user-friendly experience with features that enhance communication and engagement.

ParentSquare automatically generates an account for each parent, using their preferred email address and phone number. The accounts are generated regardless of when a parent enrolls their child. This platform is strictly for teachers and parents. The district and campus principals will continue using the current mass notification system to share information.

\*NOTE for Current Families: Accounts have been preloaded with parent and student information from the 2023 - 24 school year. As we transition to the 2024 - 25 school year, new information (updated grade levels, contact information, and student profiles) will automatically be uploaded to your account, ensuring a seamless and hassle-free process.




