Agenda Item: Annual Report for Continuing Education Credits for School Board Members for 2025-2026

DISCUSSION ITEM

RECOMMENDATION:

The president of the board publicly announce which board members have met, exceeded, or are deficient in meeting the continuing education requirements.

School board members must complete training that is required by the State Board of Education (SBOE), and the board president must publicly announce whether each board member has met the SBOE training requirements. Board members must receive continuing education training in the areas reflected in this table, according to Tex. Educ. Code §11.159; 19 Tex. Admin. Code § 61.1, 61.3

Under prior law, boards announced continuing education credit hours at the end of the calendar year. Under the new law, the time credit reporting will depend on when the district holds trustee elections.

Going forward, the time period to measure credit for elected trustees will be the 12 month period starting on the date of trustee elections in May or November to the anniversary of that date the next year.
