Leading for Learning is an initiative of Chalkboard Project that aims to enhance the leadership skills of current central office administrators across Oregon. In 2013, Chalkboard Project commissioned the Distinguished Leaders
Council to develop recommendations based on national research, best practices, and a candid appraisal of Oregon's current practices in leader preparation. Chalkboard launched the first cohort of Leading for Learning for current leaders in January 2015 in partnership with the Center for Educational Leadership (CEL)at the University of Washington.
