A. Executive Director Report

Cyber Security

Tech Tip Tuesdays was launched in January 2026 and is a simple, practical initiative designed to strengthen cybersecurity across the cooperative by delivering a short, focused tech tip to staff every Tuesday. Each email highlights a single topic, explains why it matters, and provides a few easy steps that can be applied immediately in daily work. The tips are intentionally quick to read, relevant, and actionable, supporting the goals of protecting student and staff information, reducing disruptions from cyber incidents, and building consistent, shared cybersecurity practices across MAWSECO.

Dassel-Cokato Board Visit/Tour

On January 12, the Dassel-Cokato School Board visited the Ed Center to tour and learn about the three special education programs located there. The tour



was very enlightening to the board members and provided added perspective about the students we support and programs we operate.

STEP Transition Program - Planning for FY27 and Beyond

Students Transitioning in Educational Programming (STEP) has historically capped enrollment at 25 students due to space and staffing limitations. Current enrollment is 17 students, with 16 expected to return in 2026–27. Supervisors have identified 17 potential referrals for 2026–27, which could exceed program capacity. An additional STEP teacher position has been posted to explore possible expansion; however, increased enrollment depends on securing appropriately licensed staff and addressing space and programming constraints. If staffing is not secured, enrollment will be limited to the current two-teacher model. Not all students ages 18–22 with transition needs are appropriate for STEP, and member districts will need to provide alternative transition services for some students.

Executive Director Professional Goals

Executive Director Hanson provided a mid-year progress update on her goals for the year. She is making good progress on all three and expects to achieve them by the end of the fiscal year, as planned.

B. Director of Finance Report

The teacher contract back pay and increase was processed on the 12/15/25 paycheck, which increased payroll. The additional payroll on the Board Finance Summary was due to the short time frame between meetings in December and accounts for the increase in A/P and wires. Vendor 1099 forms were sent out on January 20th. The finance department is continuing to work on department budgets and beginning to work on the revised budget.
