Subject: Consider Approval of 2023 Bond First-Sale Program Specific Technology Device Replacements – Cooperative Contract(s) (TC01)

Background Information:

- Included in the 2023 Bond proposal was Proposition C to update and purchase instructional technology equipment, including instructional learning devices and enterprise systems, such as Student Information Systems and Enterprise Resource Planning Systems that manage and secure student and staff data.
- If approved, this recommendation can help provide the necessary technology, including but not limited to computers, laptops, tablets, and related products and services that enhance the learning environment for students and staff.
- Program-specific technology consists of a broad range of areas, which include curriculum programs and computer labs, administrative offices, and other locations. Program-specific devices are a separate purchase from the iPads used in the 1:X program.
- As devices continue to age, there is a general risk of incurring more repair costs, technical support, and downtime. In a high-quality learning environment, it is essential to provide reliable and efficient technology to support students and staff.
- If approved by the Board of Trustees, various classrooms/campuses/departments in the following programs will receive device refreshes based on the current technology specifications:
 - Career and Technical Education (CTE) Programs – Business labs, Welding, MS STEM, and Tech Apps
 - Special Education
 - District office, campus, café, health services, library
- An initial Request for Quote (RFQ #03-2026) was issued to Lewisville ISD-eligible cooperative contract vendors for various technology devices and products to receive market pricing and help obtain the best value. If approved, additional requests for quotes will be issued for future purchases of devices, products, and services as needed.
- Awarded vendors under cooperative contracts have undergone a competitive procurement process that complies with Texas local and state procurement laws, allowing the District the option to request multiple quotes for products and services to help determine the best value.

- Best value involves considering several factors, which may include, but are not limited to, price, quality, availability, delivery timing, support, and other relevant factors.

Administrative Consideration:

- Lewisville ISD conducted a Request for Quote (RFQ #03-2026), notifying 1,009 vendors and received eight responses.
- Funds for these purchases come from Technology 2023 Bond Funds, departmental funds, and operational funds.
- Anticipated expenditures for this recommendation: \$3,973,896
- This procurement complies with Section 44.031 of the Texas Education Code and other applicable state and local procurement laws.

Recommendations:

- That the Lewisville ISD Board of Trustees approves the use of a Lewisville ISD-eligible cooperative contract(s), the associated vendors, and expenditures for the 2023 Bond First-Sale Program Specific Technology Device Replacements for one year.
