

Summer School Proposal 2020

Board of Education Report

This year summer school will be held at Westview School from July 6th to July 31st. We will serve PreK-7th grade Academic Intervention students for free except for the cost of busing. Students who need busing will be charged \$25.00.

Registration is March 2nd-March 27th. Registrations will not be accepted after the March 27th deadline.

Rate of Pay

The rate of pay is \$39.02 per hour for the 4 weeks. Teachers will work 4 hours a day equaling \$3121.60 for the summer. A 3.5% increase over last year.

Academic Intervention Program - The Academic Intervention Program is designed for students who are performing below grade level standards in PreK-7th grade in language arts and math. Students enrolled in the Academic Intervention Program were pre-selected using assessment data. This list was reviewed with the classroom teachers and adjustments were made, if necessary.

Students will be grouped by current grade level with a ratio of 1 teacher to 10 students (PreK will be a 1 to 10 ratio with a shared paraprofessional). Depending on enrollment, grade levels may be combined but the teacher/student ratio will stay at 10. The final determination of classes for the intervention programs will be made at the beginning of May.
