DESCRIPTION:

The Art staff have engaged in the district Continuous Improvement Process (CIP) review tasks over the past two years in the RESEARCH and PILOT phases. They have been active in activities that have included:

- development of a program goal to guide the selection of resources and to formulate the vision for instructional delivery
- review of state standards
- investigation of technology tools to enhance student learning
- o discussions of preferred resources and development of resource scenarios
- o consensus-building to reach recommendation decisions

These CIP tasks have now culminated into the K-12 Art Curriculum Adoption Proposal (CAP) Report being presented to you for review at this time. The recommendations included here provide student opportunities that align with the goals of the standards, as well as the program vision.

This review process has allowed an opportunity for our Art teachers to reflect upon the future learning experiences desired for BHM students.

Upon completing the review process, the team is bringing forth recommendations for consideration within their CAP report. With these needs and desired goals, of course, comes a commitment of purchase for instructional resources in order to meet these needs and goals. Given the district's current budget situation, we are recommending the purchase approval of only the Priority 1 requests.

Preliminary budget figures are listed below.
