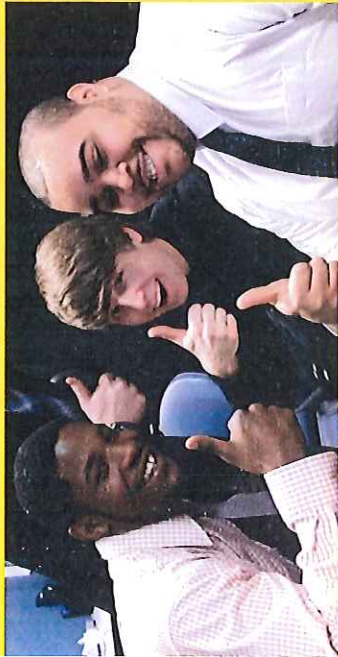

80% completed the internship.

- 180,000 job openings are in the Chicago area.

MCIP Program Elements

- A 3-week "Manufacturing Boot Camp" prepares participants for the reality of personal responsibility and accountability.
- Provides a 10-hr. OSHA Safety Training and Certification.
- Manufacturing Ambassadors provide tours and peer-to-peer presentations.
- Selection process allows interns and employers to meet and determine best fit.
- Internship allows interns to get their "feet wet" and "hands dirty" to see if they are ready to start a career in manufacturing.
