MEMORANDUM

Subject: Consider and possible Board action to approve request for competitive sealed proposals

for risk management insurance provider (RFP#25-1161)

Date: September 17, 2024

HISTORY: The current contract for commercial insurance coverage was approved by the Board of Trustees on September 8, 2021 for the three-year period of 10/1/21 through 9/30/24 and was awarded to TASB. The insurance premium cost for year one (10/1/21 - 9/30/22) was \$208,136, for year two (10/1/22 - 9/30/23) was \$234,967 and for the current year 3 (10/1/23 - 9/30/24) was \$305,768. Premiums are based on claim history and new assets insured have increased year by year.

RATIONALE: Specifications for the RFP were developed based on Texas Department of Insurance regulations and competitive sealed proposals were received by the district until August 13, 2024 at 2:00 pm. The solicitation called for interested proposers to submit insurance deductibles, limits of coverage and premiums for a coverage period of three years with the option to extend for an additional one-year term. Only one proposal was received and it was submitted by TASB. The tabulation of results is as follows:
