Subject: Create Prevention Coordinator Position 2019/2020 (If grant is awarded)

Description: We are currently partnering on a grant with the School Based Health Clinic. The grant is a match; BPS would pay ½ salary and School Based Clinic will pay ½ Salary.

Prevention Coordinator:

The Browning Public School's Prevention Coordinator is a full-time eleven month Professional/Technical position that will coordinate prevention and healthy lifestyle education and activities at Browning Public Schools in conjunction with staff, faculty, and cooperating partners. The Prevention Coordinator will be responsible for working with partners to create prevention plan for school based on analysis of data to include evidence-based and culturally appropriate prevention education measured through formative and summative evaluation.

The goal of the Browning Public Schools Green and Clean Project is to raise awareness and help students obtain the benefits of a healthy life through prevention education. This will be obtained through a coordinated effort that includes students and staff learning about a variety of prevention efforts that are coordinated throughout the school in conjunction with tribal, county, and state programs that provide prevention education. Prevention Coordinator will work closely with Southern Piegan School-Based Health Care Clinic, community engagement, and outreach.
