




Academic Achievement: STAAR Performance (Meets and Above)


(24-25) STAAR Reading Performance (Meets or Above)



Campus Improvement Plan Goals

Performance Objectives (Goals)	
Goal 1	By May 2026, Collegiate Preparatory Elementary School will improve the percentage of 3rd-5th Grade scholars meeting grade-level standards on the 2026 STAAR Reading Assessment from 69% to 75%.
Goal 2	By May 2026, Collegiate Prep Elementary School will increase the percentage of 3rd-5th Grade scholars meeting grade-level standards on the 2026 STAAR Math Assessment from 64% Meets to 70% Meets.
Goal 3	By May 2026, Collegiate Prep Elementary will increase the percentage of scholars identified as College, Career and Military Ready Graduates from 80% to 85% by August 2028.
Goal 4	By May 2026, Collegiate Preparatory Elementary School will improve the percentage of 5th-grade scholars meeting grade-level standards on the STAAR Science Assessment from 49% to 60%.


Action Items
