

Indoor Hitting Facility Proposal

October 17th, 2016

The Minico High School Baseball/Softball Coaching Staffs and community members would like to get board approval to pursue the establishment of an Indoor Hitting Facility at Minico High School.

The purpose of this building is to have a space for the baseball and softball teams to work out during winter, and early spring when the weather doesn't cooperate. The inside of our building will be equipped with batting cages, bullpen areas, and extra room for defensive drills. We are pursuing a building that is 60'x112'. We feel that we are at a disadvantage to other teams in our conference because they have facilities like this at their schools. We received a foot of snow at the end of March causing both the baseball and softball teams to miss 4 days of practice, before playing conference games on that Friday and Saturday. With an indoor hitting facility we could get out of the bad weather, and still get good work in to prepare for our games.

We can build this building in 4 phases. Phase 1 being the road base gravel and site prep. Phase 2 would be the construction of the building shell. Phase 3 is the installation of electricity and gas for heat. Phase 4 is the interior walls, turf and cages.

We have discussed and reviewed 3 different bids that we have received for this job. Each bid has its own positives and negatives.

Option 1 – Cleary Building (Pole Barn Style) – 60'x112' -- \$69,999

Option 2 – Olympia Steel Frame Building – 68'x100' -- \$48,621

Option 3 – Block Building – 68'x100' -- \$132,600

Several locations have been discussed for the building, but narrowed to what should be our final location. This location is right behind the center field fence of the varsity baseball field. This location can be referred to on the map on the last page.

We have also discussed many different options for fundraising for the indoor hitting facility. A few of these options include: a dinner, a raffle, and a call-a-thon. We have started receiving commitment for funds, and as soon as we have final approval checks will be received. We are also open to other ideas and suggestions to raise the money needed. We are looking for and would greatly appreciate any and all support from the School Board and the School District.

We are here today seeking approval from the board to move forward with this project. We have discussed all three bids, and feel the Cleary Building is the best building for us. Cleary Building can begin building in January, and have the building up in a couple weeks. We would like your approval to move forward with the road base gravel and the Cleary building.

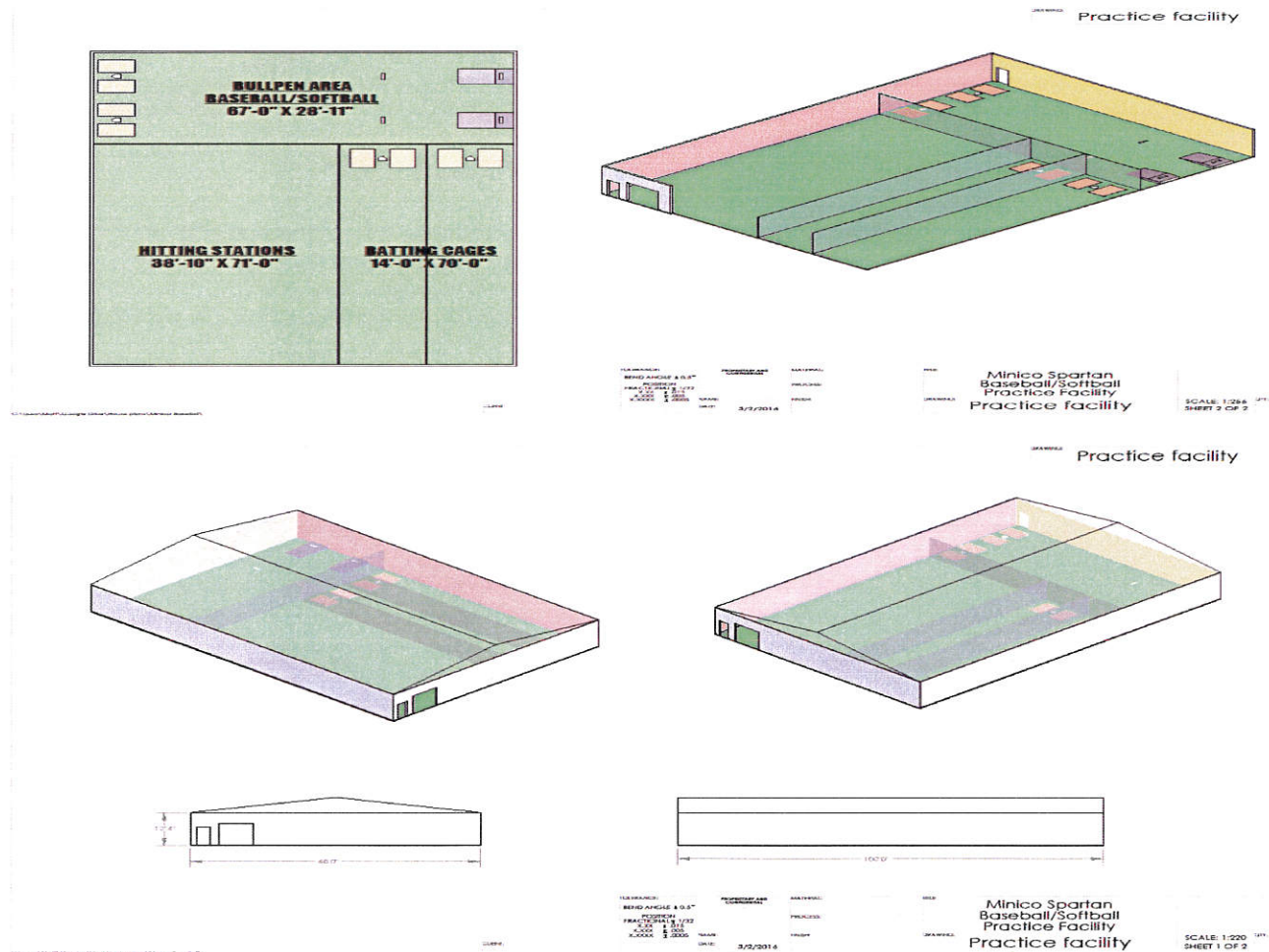
MINICO HIGH SCHOOL HITTING & PITCHING FACILITY
