The Board of Education of the Davis School District will hold a Public Hearing to receive community input on a proposal to balance student enrollment across affected schools. The boundary proposal realigns student enrollment for Bluff Ridge Elementary, Buffalo Point Elementary, Cook Elementary, Island View Elementary, and Syracuse Elementary schools and establishes boundaries for the new elementary school opening in August 2026.
