

# **Workforce Division Monthly Board Report**

February 2026

## **Summary/Overview**

In the annual academic timeline, February is when we start planning for budget development and schedules for summer and fall semesters. We are also preparing for our next Industrial Technology Advisory Committee. We are currently taking inventory and documenting the applicability of our Industrial Training Equipment for planning purposes.

The Safety Training Center (STC) continues to provide required safety training to the Northern Panhandle Region. The technicians assigned to work at the various plants and refineries cannot do so until they receive the training and subsequent STC documentation. This is a critical mission which supports the regional workforce.

## **Business and Industry Partners Served**

This month the Safety Training Center served 38 regional business and industry partners.

This month we delivered 561 courses to over 200 individuals.

## **Total Monthly Revenues**
