Summary:	<p>Campus planning and site-based decision-making, defined by Texas Education Code Section 11.253, requires the development of campus improvement plans. The campus principal, with the assistance of the site-based decision committee, must develop, review and revise the campus improvement plan for the purpose of improving student performance for all student populations each year.</p> <p>On each campus, the Campus Excellence Committee (CEC), comprised of staff, parents and community members led by the campus principal, engages in the continuous improvement process to conduct a Comprehensive Needs Assessment (CNA). The CNA provides identified strengths and areas of needed improvement, and specifies priorities for developing and revising plans. The purpose is to align goals, objectives, strategies and actions resulting in high levels of performance for all students</p>

and student groups, close learning gaps, and support systemic change to sustain excellence over time. Campus plans are aligned to the District Improvement Plan and to the GCISD Balanced Scorecard.
