<u>Policies</u> The agenda includes additional policies that can be approved on a first reading by the Board. These policy updates are primarily driven by statute changes and are recommended by MSBA.

<u>MCAs</u> Administration will give an overview of Spring 2024 MCA results. Overall, we are pleased with the results and proud of our teachers and students for the growth!

<u>Food Service Updates and Contracting with St. John's for Food Service Director Services</u> L-A Food Service Director will provide updates on our Food Service programs, and her work with HVED and proposed contract with St. John's Lutheran School.

School Board Recognition Month; Public School Board Members Have Heart! MSBA is now recognizing September as School Board Appreciation month. <u>Resolution to Set Levy at Maximum:</u> The Board must approve a final levy for pay 2025 in December. In September, the Board must approve a resolution to set the levy at 'maximum'. Virtually all school districts do this. The formulas are

finalized by December and you are approving in September to approve the levy at the maximum allowed amount. Note that this is for the local levy; the district receives far more dollars in State Aid (and federal dollars).

<u>Solar Panel Projects Underway</u> Brok Johnson from Solar Connections Inc was here on September 5<sup>th</sup> to begin the final placement planning at the high school and elementary school. The high school panels will require a relocation of the discus throwing field. The grant dollars will pay for the costs to pour a different concrete pad for throwing from.

<u>Literacy Aid MOU Negotiations with EdMN/L-A</u> Board Negotiators (Maki, Pringle, Baer) will need to meet with representatives from EdMN/L-A to discuss the \$40,000 allocation to our district for the purpose of training for the READ Act. This funding requirea MOU with the Union on the funds use. I am in the process of getting clarifications on this from MASA, MDE and MSBA
