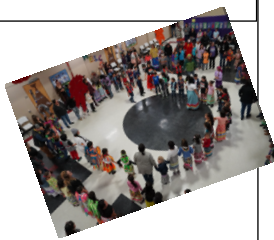
Strategic Plan Update

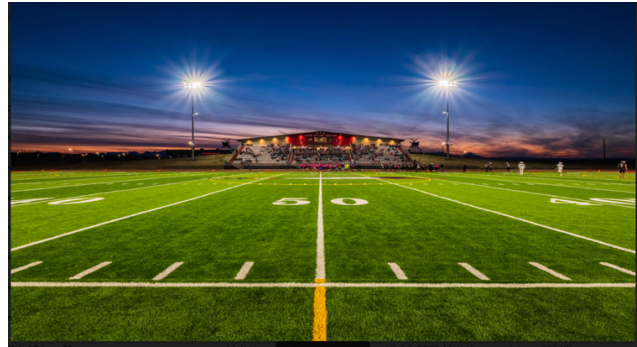
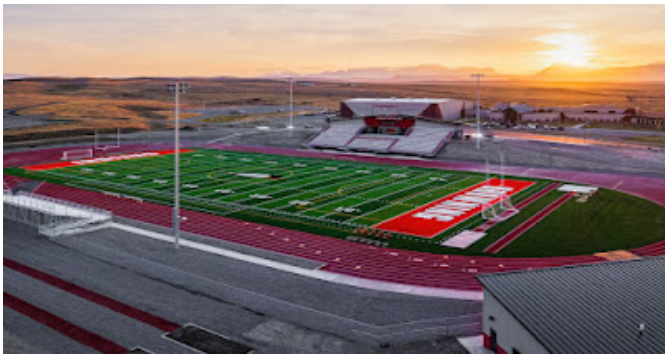
