PLAN OF ACTION

During the 2003-2004 school year, Ector County Independent School District constructed 20 new classrooms. An additional six classrooms will be constructed prior to the end of the 2004-2005 school year. Construction will continue and additional classroom space will be added through 2008.

Blanton is over the cap by five students in kindergarten. Construction scheduled for 2007 includes the addition of one classroom. The addition of portable structures will be a consideration to address the need for classroom space for the 2005-2006 school year. An aide has been hired to assist the kindergarten teachers with the overage.

Cavazos is over the cap by two students in grade one. Normal attrition should balance the class loads by the end of the semester.

Murry Fly is over the cap by one student in kindergarten. Normal attrition should balance the class loads by the end of the semester.

Goliad is over the cap by seven students in grade one. Construction plans are currently in design with the construction of two classrooms in the fall of 2005 among the improvements. The addition of portable structures will be a consideration to address the need for classroom space during the 2005-2006 construction. A change of magnet campus assignments from Austin to Ross instead of Austin to Goliad will occur prior to the next school year. Two aides have been hired to assist the first grade teachers with the overage.

Jordan is over the cap by four students in grade one. The addition of portable structures will be a consideration to address the need for classroom space for the 2005-2006 school year.

Pease is over the cap by two students in grade four. Construction scheduled for 2007 includes the addition of two classrooms. The addition of portable structures will be a consideration to address the need for classroom space for the 2005-2006 school year.

Sam Houston is over the cap by two students in grade two. The campus is currently under construction with one classroom addition among other improvements.

Travis is over the cap by one student in grade three. Construction scheduled for 2006 includes the addition of three classrooms. Normal attrition should balance the class loads by the end of the semester.
