

## **Elementary Math Textbook Adoption Process Timeline**

November	<p>-School Board approved District Textbook Committee Members (November 13<sup>th</sup>)</p> <p>-The District Textbook Committee met to develop the criteria for a quality math program in Denton ISD. Our criteria were compared to the rubric created in collaboration with the McMath Group and found to be in alignment.</p> <p>-All textbook programs were reviewed by the District Textbook Committee. The group looked for evidence of said criteria and any programs that did not meet the criteria were eliminated from the teacher review process.</p> <p>-Copies of approved titles were shipped to all campuses</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• One title per grade level, per campus</li><li>• Campuses with bilingual programs received samples in English and Spanish</li></ul>
December - February	<p>-Campus Representatives dispersed titles to teachers and teachers began reviewing and filling out rubrics</p>
February	<p>-Publisher Presentations (February 12th)</p> <p>-Teachers submitted rubrics and review notes to Campus representatives</p> <p>-Campus Representatives presented teacher input and campus results at the Textbook Committee consensus meeting (February 25<sup>th</sup>)</p>
March	<p>-Present recommendation of <u>EnVision Math Texas</u> to DISD School Board (March 11<sup>th</sup>)</p>
