

Virtual, Synchronous, and Hybrid-Schedule learning opportunities for students. (approx. current enrollment - full-time)



2025-26

Literacy and core skill development. Maintain regular synchronous learning opps. and continued connection to students and families, including SEL.

Provide students, caregivers, and staff with programming that maintains academic rigor and continued excellent communication with each.

Increase academic rigor, on-ground pre and summative assessments, continued daily synchronous learning, and in-person access to instructors. Continued Development of the CHS/CVA Learning Lab, including CHS students served virtually (onsite), CVA students engaged in on-ground access, and a Hybrid of both!

Work in collaboration with Curriculum and Student Learning to increase our learning, response and Implementation of effective, educational use of AI.
