- Parent Teacher Conferences were held on October 6th. Our attendance was up this year from last year as we had approximately 255 parents/guardians who showed up for conferences. Through our survey, parents/guardians felt that attending conferences was helpful in understanding their child's strengths and areas of improvement; the school staff are available to answer any questions, and the conferences were beneficial.
