Unity School District - Board of Education Board Policy 352.3 School Sponsored Extended Field Trips Last Revised 10/8/2019

The Board authorizes and requires the administration to approve school sponsored extended trips for students. Extended trips are those trips involving overnight arrangements and are considered to be part of the school's curriculum, programming, extra-curricular, and co-curricular activities. Extended travel may be used as an incentive or reward for participation in activities, however, the school should encourage and motivate individuals/groups by properly placing trips in the total curricular structure.

All proposals for school sponsored extended trips shall be presented to the administration prior to any formal discussion with students parents/guardians or public announcements.

Participation in school sponsored extended trips shall be voluntary.

Only trips that conform to this policy, meet administrative requirements, and have been approved by the administration are recognized as Unity School District trips. The District shall not permit use of facilities, time or staff involvement in advertising or promotion of unauthorized trips or tours.
