Please see attached MOA for EdTech Infusion for additional information. Contractor will provide distance and in-person training based on HB44 mandate for Non-Violent Crisis Intervention to all staff. Contractor will support all sites with the development, and implementation, of a positive school climate intervention based on SW-PBIS evidence-based practices. Contractor will provide training to staff for the development and implementation of Restorative Practices and Restorative Circles for classroom and specific social emotional needs. Contractor will provide assistance with the developing a system for social emotional distance delivery methods utilizing zoom, Googlemeet, and other platforms as approved by NSBSD. Contract Period: July 01, 2020 through June 30, 2021. Total MOA not to exceed \$55,000.00 with travel.

Once the award is received and the budget is developed in Tyler, grant funds will be used for this service as outline in Indian Ed, Title IV (Social/emotional & Trauma informed support) and ANEP.**
