BACKGROUND:

Brownsville ISD seeks approval to enter into a consultant services agreement with Liberty Source / Harris Education Solutions to deliver on-site professional development focused on the effective implementation and use of the Tango Software platform. The targeted, hands-on beginning-of-year training sessions are designed to support campus and instructional leaders in using Tango tools to strengthen instructional planning and data-informed decision-making. The sessions will provide in-depth guidance on interpreting Tango data, aligning insights to instructional strategies, conducting pacing and checkpoint readiness audits, and setting performance targets. Additionally, participants will receive support in analyzing STAAR performance, planning cross-functional interventions, regrouping students for growth, and implementing new features within the Tango platform to enhance campus-level operations and student achievement. The services provided are critical for maximizing the impact of existing educational tools and ensuring district-wide consistency in instructional strategies.

255 Budgeted funds will be utilized for a total cost of \$102,500.00.

Rationale for Strategic Beginning-of-Year Training Sessions

These targeted, beginning-of-year strategic training sessions are intentionally designed for delivery by experts with specialized knowledge of the Tango platform, instructional data analysis, and campus-level operational dynamics. The purpose is to ensure that campus and instructional leaders receive precise, high-leverage guidance that cannot be generalized or replicated without a deep understanding of the following critical elements:

- 1. In-depth interpretation of Tango data and tools, customized by subject area and grade level—requiring advanced familiarity with platform logic, metrics, and student performance indicators.
- 2. Strategic alignment of data insights to actionable instructional moves, empowering teachers to make immediate course corrections grounded in best-practice implementation strategies that hinge on expert-level modeling.
- 3. Cross-functional support planning, including how all campus staff can contribute to prescriptive instruction, remediation, and tutoring efforts—requiring facilitation from individuals who understand both instructional models and campus workflows.
- 4. STAAR performance analysis and the cascading instructional implications for curriculum design, scope and sequence, and resource allocation—an exercise that demands experience with longitudinal data trends and campus-level planning.
- 5. Campus-type-specific solutioning, addressing distinct instructional and structural challenges:
 - Elementary: platform onboarding, literacy benchmarks, bilingual student transitions
 - Middle School: literacy proficiency, behavioral interruptions, compressed instructional minutes
 - High School: CCMR alignment, career pathway development (PGPs), dual credit programming, and extracurricular impacts
- **6.** Checkpoint and pacing readiness audits, requiring nuanced awareness of curriculum frameworks and real-time instructional pacing models.
- 7. Performance target setting, based on data-driven evaluations of new student rosters and prior year performance—best conducted by those with mastery in performance forecasting and instructional grouping.
- **8. Rostering optimization**, including regrouping strategies designed to maximize growth and outcomes, guided by predictive data models and student history trends.
- Introduction and guided implementation of new Tango functionality, including the Explorer student
 portal—requiring trainers fluent in both the technical aspects and the instructional application of new
 tools.

This training is not generic professional development. It is a highly specialized, data-driven planning session delivered by content and platform experts uniquely equipped to guide strategic campus transformation from day one.
