Subject: Consider Approval of the Use of Capital Projects Funds for School Safety Related Projects				
Background: Last month \$100,000 in Capital Projects funds were approved for the purchase of tasers for the SRO Division. We obtained a proposal from the manufacturer (Axon) earlier this month, and the cost of the hardware and 1 <sup>st</sup> year certification is more than we had anticipated. Additional Bonds 2017 Savings and Interest of \$23,161 are requested for the hardware portion of the proposal. Year 1 certification costs will be funded out of the 2024-25 General Fund budget. We have also included annual certification costs in the 2025-26 General Fund budget that will be presented in August. The vendor has confirmed that the tasers will be delivered prior to 8/31 if we order by the end of July.
