Public Law 105.17, known as the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), requires that school districts provide a free and appropriate education to all disabled children and young adults from birth through 21 years of age. This is an opportunity for next year's Kindergarteners who will be attending Evergreen for the first time for an orientation, meet the teachers, visit the classrooms, and submit paperwork.

Students must be five years old on or before the first day of September to attend Kindergarten (NO EXCEPTIONS). At this time we are projecting full time kindergarten for next year.

The Oregon law requires children initially entering school to be fully or currently up-to-date on immunizations prior to enrollment. Please bring a copy of the child's birth certificate to verify age and immunization records.
