EARLY ADMISSION FOR HIGH-SCHOOL STUDENTS

I. PURPOSE

Describes the conditions under which high-school secondary school students may be admitted to the college.

II. BACKGROUND AND/OR LEGAL REFERENCE

Not applicable. Texas Adminstrative Code, Title 19, Part 1, Chapter 4, Rule 4.85

III. POLICY

- A. As a means of recognizing superior high-school achievement, WCJC shall permit qualified high-school secondary school students to enroll for college courses in a summer session or to enroll in college courses—enroll while concurrently—enrolled in with high-school enrollment secondary school course work.
- B. To qualify for early admissions, high-schoolsecondary students must meet the following conditions:
 - 1.——Completion of the sophomore year of high school.the equivalent of 8th grade;
 - 12. Recommendation by the high-school principal, or designee, or chief instructional officer;
 - 23. Consent of parent if student is under 18 years old.
 - 34. Meets the Texas State Initiative as required by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board, and
 - 45. Satisfies the college prerequisites for a designated for specific course work.

IV. PROCEDURES

- A. The student submits a completed WCJC admissions application, a completed Certification for Early Admission form (located on the WCJC website), an official transcript of previous academic work, and documentation of test scores to the Office of Admissions & Registration.
- B. The Director of Admissions and Registration evaluates the application and notifies the secondary school student of acceptance or rejection. The student may appeal the decision if the case meets the criteria for appeal stipulated in Reg 591. Student Grievances.
