1. Background:

§44.0331 of the Texas Education Code (TEC) requires school districts to provide a written report, annually in an open meeting, to the Board of Trustees which includes memberships, the purpose, and disposition of any fee for purchasing contracts valued at \$50,000 or more under Section 44.031(a) (5), under Subchapter F, Chapter 271, Local Government Code, or under any other cooperative purchasing program authorized for school districts.

2. Process:

§44.031(a)(4) of TEC allows school districts to purchase through interlocal cooperative programs.

3. Fiscal Impact:
