STAAR EOC (Estimated) and TAKS Results

The following are our **estimated** results of our STAAR End of Course tests based upon the Level II Phase in standard released by the state. Only freshmen enrolled in these courses took the EOC tests. ELA Writing had higher standards than the other tests. In order to meet Level II Phase in standard in writing, you had to make a 60 or better. In order to meet Level II Recommended standard you had to make a 70 or better. In all other subjects, the Level II Phase In standard was a 40 and above and the Level II Recommended was a 60 or better.

***STAAR scores for grades 3-8 are not available as the state will not set a standard until January. All we have available are individual student's raw scores.

These are all estimated based on our best guess for STAAR EOC:

<u>STAAR EOC – Freshman enrolled in these courses:</u> Algebra 1 – 88% met level 2 phase in standard Geometry – 100% met level 2 phase in standard Biology – 96% met level 2 phase in standard Reading – 87% met level 2 phase in standard Writing – 67% met level 2 phase in standard World History – 71% met level 2 phase in standard World Geography – 100% met level 2 phase in standard

The following are the <u>TAKS scores for 10th and 11th graders</u>:

<u>TAKS – 10th grade:</u> English Language Arts – 96% met standard, 23% commended Math – 88% met standard, 21% commended Social Studies – 99% met standard, 69% commended Science – 97% met standard, 38% commended

<u>TAKS – 11th grade:</u> English Language Arts – 95% met standard, 25% commended Math – 98% met standard, 24% commended Social Studies – 100% met standard, 74% commended Science – 99% met standard, 26% commended
