POLICY TITLE: Salutatorian &- Valedictorian Selection

Minidoka County Joint School District # 331

The following requirements shall be considered in the selection of <u>Minico High School and Mt.</u> <u>Harrison High School</u> Valedictorian and Salutatorian:

- 1. Complete all requirements of the Diploma.
- 2. <u>Minico students must Cc</u>omplete a minimum of 15 credits of honors or dual credit courses, five of which must be taken during the senior year.
- 3. The student with the highest overall GPA in grades nine through twelve, including the final term of the senior year will be eligible for Valedictorian. If more than one student meets the criteria, valedictorian and salutatorian will be determined by the highest SAT score.
- 4. In the event a grade is disputed, that issue shall be resolved by the end of the term the course is taken.
- 5. Students being considered for Valedictorian or Salutatorian must have attended <u>Mt.</u> <u>Harrison or</u> Minico High School full time for all of their senior year.
- 6. <u>Minico s</u>Students being considered for Valedictorian or Salutatorian shall not have repeated any classes.

<u>Minico</u> Graduates with a cumulative GPA of 3.75 or higher will be recognized at graduation with an honor cord.

Mt. Harrison graduates with a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher will be recognized at graduation with an honor cord.
