## **Background Information:**

- Computer Automation Systems, Inc. (CAS) sold Keller ISD a program called SEAS over three years ago. SEAS is a web-based special education management program. SEAS never worked in any way for the District.
- The District has purchased another special education program that functions well and meets our needs. There is no hope that SEAS will ever work, nor do we have any interest in it at this time.
- The District has attempted to resolve the issues with CAS informally, but it must now either formally settle the claims with CAS or pursue litigation against it.

## **Administrative Considerations:**

- The administration believes settling the matter for \$55,000 is the most sensible course of action.
- The settlement agreement has been reviewed by Amanda Bigbee, General Counsel.
