## Cell Phone Guideline Changes

#### Current Guideline, page 61

For instructional and safety purposes, the district permits students to possess personal mobile telephones; however, these devices must remain turned off during the instructional day, including during all testing, unless they are being used for approved instructional purposes.

#### **Proposed Guideline**

For instructional purposes Denton ISD will be the sole provider of instructional technology. Use of technology during the school day is limited district provided technology.

phones and personal telecommunications devices on campus such as laptops, tablets, or other portable computers. Use of each of these items is strictly prohibited without approval of a principal or classroom teacher. These devices should remain off and not visible during the school day.

### **Violent Offenses Consideration**

#### Current Guidelines, page 73

- 4. Persistent offenses (two or more previous suspensions) for fighting (42.01, 6) will result in DAEP placement.
- 5. Offenses for assault will result in a 3-day suspension and a DAEP placement (Ch.37).

#### **Proposed Guidelines**

- 4. Fighting (first offense) may result in a DAEP placement.
- 5. Persistent offenses (two or more previous suspensions) for fighting or assault (42.01, 6) will result in DAEP placement.
