COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course provides students with the tools needed to deal with conflict in a constructive manner. Methods for resolving one's own conflicts, workplace issues, and mediation will be discussed. Strategies to remain drug and alcohol free are also part of the course.

COURSE GOALS:

Students will:

- 1. Learn that conflict is a normal process of every day life.
- 2. Train in a variety of methods to deal with conflict.
- 3. Gain a better understanding of themselves and others.
- 4. Learn how to mediate student to student conflicts on the IVHS campus.
- 5. Understand how to avoid drugs and alcohol.

Students will be graded on class participation, written assignments, class presentations, and quizzes.
