The Designated Polling Place for Sub-District II will be the Library at Moreno Middle School, 301 North Minnesota. The Polling Place for Early Voting for Sub-District I will be the Marion B. Horton School Gym at A.C. Jones High School, 1902 N. Adams Street and for Sub-District II the Early Voting Polling Place will be the Library of the Moreno Middle School, 301 North Minnesota. The motion was seconded by Tom Beasley and carried by unanimous vote.
