4 Policy Name: Conflict of Interest

Regulation: -----

A trustee may not:

1. engage in a substantial financial transaction for his/her private business purpose with a person whom he/she supervises in the course of official duties;

2. perform an official act directly and substantially affecting to its economic benefit to a business or other undertaking in which the trustee either has a substantial financial interest or is engaged as counsel, consultant, representative or agent;

3. act as an agent or solicitor in the sale or supply of goods or services to a district;

4. have a monetary interest, directly or indirectly, in any contract made by the Board of Trustees when the trustee has more than a ten percent (10%) interest in the corporation. A contract does not include: 1) merchandise sold to the highest bidder at public auctions; 2) investments or deposits in financial institutions which are in the business of loaning or receiving money when such investments or deposits are made on a rotating or ratable basis among financial institutions in the community or when there is only one financial institution in the community; or 3) contracts for professional services other than salaried services or for maintenance or repair services or supplies when the services or supplies are not reasonably available from other sources. In order to award a contract under these circumstances a determination of the lack of availability of the service or product in question must be entered in the minutes of the Board meeting at which the contract is considered. Further, the name(s) of the specific Board member(s) involved must be included in the minutes. Board Members negotiating contracts with the District are prohibited from voting on any aspect of the decision made by the Board.

5. be employed in any capacity by the District, with the exception of officiating at athletic competitions under the auspices of the Montana Officials Association.

6. perform an official act directly and substantially affecting a business or other undertaking to its economic detriment when the officer or employee has a substantial personal interest in a competing firm or undertaking.

7. perform an official act directly and substantially affecting to its economic benefit a business or other undertaking in which the officer or employee either has a substantial financial interest or is engaged as counsel, consultant, representative, or agent.

8. appoint to a position of trust any person related or connected by consanguinity within the fourth (4th) degree or by affinity within the second degree (2nd).

- a. this prohibition does not apply to the issuance of an employment contract to a person as a substitute teacher who is not employed as a substitute teacher for more than 30 consecutive school days.
- b. this prohibition does not apply to the renewal of an employment contract of person who was initially hired before the Board member to whom he/she is related assumed the position
- c. this prohibition does not apply if the trustees comply with the following requirements: 1 All trustees, except the trustee related to the person to be employed or appointed, vote to
