Construction Plans Finalized, Project Begins

- The Unity Board of Education approved the final design of the facilities construction project at a meeting in May with Kraus Anderson and DSGW Architects.
- The site work specifications have been sent out to contractors for bidding. The plan is to complete the parking lot work in late July and early August.
- The construction staging areas in front of the high school will be put into place in late August.
- The plans for the precast wall panels have been released for production. Their spot in the production schedule has been secured for the project.
- The construction specifications for the building additions/renovations are being completed. The specifications will be going out in July for a September start.
