Goal 2*: Increased overall student performance in mathematics to 85% Meets Standard by 2028. The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase from 53% to 65% by June 2024, 70% for 2024-2025, 75% for 2025-2026, 80% for 2026-2027, 85% for 2027-2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**

Goal 3*: The percentage of graduates that meet the criteria for CCMR will increase from 72% to 88% by August 2024 and increase to 95% by 2028. (HB3 Required Goal)

Our district has seen a continual increase in our emergent bilingual program numbers, especially with newcomers. With this growth, we have been developing a strong ESL program by adding an additional ESL specialist for the K-5 campuses and an additional ESL paraprofessional for the K-5 campuses. Through this thoughtful planning, we have been able to provide customized supports for these students based on their individual needs and this has resulted in a significant increase in our student performance data. With the addition of an ESL paraprofessional at the secondary campuses, we can replicate these effective practices and results.
