FPC Rahll Campus Board Report October 2025

- The Rahll Campus hosted a cookout for National Cheeseburger Day on September 25th. We had a fabulous turnout, and we served around 525 burgers.
- Participated in numerous calls and training courses for the Windam School to offer courses at the TDCJ Unit in Dalhart. They have executed official contracts with FPC to proceed with the process to begin classes in Fall of 2026. Christy will attend an in-person 3-day training course in Huntsville the week of October 20th.
- The Rahll Campus Advisory Board met for a quarterly meeting. They approved to use Rahll Campus Reserve Funds to develop a CDL Training and Testing Pad on campus. The Dalhart airport is in the process of building additional hangers as well as starting a flight school. We will no longer be able to use the airport to train or test our CDL students starting in Spring of 2026. This move is vital to us being able to continue to offer CDL. We are currently obtaining bids for this project.
- The Diesel HDJT Grant is completed. PRPC traveled to Dalhart to take inventory and tag all the purchased equipment.
- Courtney and Christy attended the FPC Scholarship Banquet in Borger.
- Christian and Courtney attended the TACRAO College fair at Dalhart High School.
- A CDL Department meeting with held to discuss the new Executive Order which enforces CDL License holders to meet English Language Proficiency Standards. Law Enforcement Agencies are already conducting roadside checks on drivers to ensure all drivers meet the standards. Christy worked with Dr. McNabb, Dalhart theory instructor, to develop an in-depth curriculum to prepare our CDL students. The Rahll Campus started an ESL for CDL course for our students. Providing this service to our communities will help prospective students to be able to earn their CDL.
- The Rahll Campus is starting a Professor and Student Spotlight series to help our students learn more about their professors and to spotlight our students.
- Christy attended the local Emergency Management Response Team meeting.
- Met with Hilmar regarding the possibility of partnering with them to start an I&E Apprenticeship.
- New class of ESL and GED starts on October 13th.
- Quarterly TCOLE Meeting was held on October 15th.
- Staff are working on recruiting strategies for Spring enrollment.
