### **Background Information**

The certification of the appraisal roll from Dallas Central Appraisal District (DCAD) is required by law pursuant to Section 26.01 paragraphs (a) and (b) of the Texas Property Tax Code. The appraisal roll ensures that certified values from the DCAD are incorporated into the district's tax rate adoption, budget, and financial planning. This process is important in assisting with revenue projections, compliance with state funding formulas, and transparency to taxpayers.

# **Administrative Considerations**

Certified values directly affect the district's tax rate adoption and local share of school funding. Adoption of the certified appraisal roll provides the official property valuation base for Fiscal Year 2025-26.

#### Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees accept and adopt the certified appraisal roll as presented.

## **Communication Deployment**

Following Board approval, administration will update the tax rate adoption documents and post required notices in compliance with Truth-in-Taxation guidelines.
