<u>Meeting Called to Order</u>: Dr. Steve Brown, Board Vice-President, called the Board of Trustees Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

<u>Presentation: Population and Survey Analysts (PASA) Demographic Data Update</u>: Chief Data Analyst of PASA Kris Pool and Dr. Sarah Ashburn provided Trustees with a demographic data update back on April 11, 2017 and at the request of Board of Trustee Dr. Donna Smith returned to provide a more indepth report. The demographers put together 5-year and 10-year potential growth scenarios. They reviewed demographic trends, employment trends, housing projections, ratios of students per household, and projected student enrollment. They noted that housing trends are key to analyzing and predicting growth. In the first quarter of 2017, 155 new home construction building permits had been issued, a 40% to 50% increase from 2016. Most of the growth is to the northeast part of Ector County and is expected to continue. They pointed out that, through their experience, even if the growth numbers don't hit predictions the location of that growth will hold consistent.
