General Rules:

- To enter, a student must be an FFA member in good standing and enrolled in Agricultural Science classes.
- Contests will be conducted according to the Current State Career Development Event Rules and Regulations as
 posted on the Texas FFA Web site.
- Schools may enter as many students as they wish within each contest area. However, each student may only
 compete in one CDE area with exception to the Land CDE and Homesite CDE where one student may enter
 both due to nature of those two contests.
- Due to space limitations the Meats CDE, Horse CDE, & Vet. Science CDE will be capped for student numbers.
 Meats will be capped at 140 students, Horse at 350 students, and Vet. Science at 200 students.
- Teams will consist of 3 or 4 members.
- All individuals, and teams, are eligible for awards.
- It is the responsibility of Chapters with more than 4 members judging in a contest to designate "Team 1, Team
 2, etc." on scans sheets using the code feature. Teams not designating teams correctly will not be eligible for team awards. A sample scan sheet can be found on judgingcard.com.

- Students will use Mac computers in the WTAMU Mac Lab




Sample Scan Sheet for WTAMU

- 6. West Texas A&M will not have scan sheets for sale the day of the contest.


WTAMU Campus and Area Map
