Hi all for the month March the Transportation Department added two new bus drivers, they were updated with CPR and first aid certification. Welcome Crystal Upham and Laura Trombley.

The shop has almost completed 50 work orders, we have 3 propane buses that the fuel pump need to be installed; this is a 1 week process per each bus. the shop has started there spring cleaning, like painting and reorganizing whenever they can, so were asking any departments that has a school vehicle please turn in your bi-weekly walk arounds so our shop can keep your school vehicles safe.
