DATE OF MEETING: January 25, 2022

TITLE: RISE, Tutoring and Summer School Teacher Hourly Rate Increase 2022

BACKGROUND:

The current pandemic we are facing has increased the need for students to receive additional support in the areas of reading and math. As we move our "Rebound" forward it is imperative that we have strong and highly effective teachers teaching our most vulnerable populations to increase their achievement and decrease the learning opportunity gap. With that being said, we must increase teacher hourly rate for the RISE, Tutoring and Summer School for the following years; 2022 and through Fall of 2023. This rate increase will ensure we have enough teachers to help serve our children.

ESSER III funds will be used for this purpose. The Board previously approved the ESSER III budget which included intensive instruction in the areas of Reading and Math.

We propose the approval of the new hourly rate of \$42.00 per hour from Spring of 2022 through the Fall of 2023.

RECOMMENDATION:

The administration recommends that the Governing Board approve the RISE, Tutoring and Summer School Teacher hourly rate increase for 2022 through Fall of 2023 as detailed in the above background information.
