2016 Special Education Determination Status

In accordance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) (20 U.S.C. 1416(a)(3)(B)), the Texas Education Agency (TEA) collects and reviews data associated with Indicators 11, 12, and 13 through the State Performance Plan (SPP).

Indicator 11: Percent of children who were evaluated within 45 school days of receiving parental consent for initial evaluation.

Indicator 12: Percent of children referred by Part C prior to age 3, who are found eligible for Part B, and who have an IEP developed and implemented by their third birthdays.

Indicator 13: Percent of youth with IEPs aged 16 and above with an IEP that includes appropriate measurable postsecondary goals that are annually updated and based upon an age appropriate transition assessment, transition services, including courses of study, that will reasonably enable the student to meet those postsecondary goals, and annual IEP goals related to the student's transition service needs.
