## INFORMATIONAL REPORT:

Beginning in the 2018-2019 all students taking dual credit courses must pass with a grade of "70" or better in order to receive high school credit.

Beginning with students who entered 9<sup>th</sup> grade in 2018-2019 and thereafter, students will be required to complete all United ISD graduation requirements as referenced in the Foundation High School Program and must do so in the designated grade level.

# Beginning 2018-2019 for **all** High School Students Enrolled in Dual Credit

- Numerical grades from Laredo College will be provided for 2018-2019 school year and thereafter, a student **must** earn a grade of 70 or better in order to receive dual credit for the high school course.
- As per TAC-Chapter 74. Curriculum Requirements Subchapter C. Other Provisions 74.26 Award of Credit (c) Credit for courses for high school graduation may be earned only if the student received a grade which is the equivalent of 70 on a scale of 100, based upon the essential knowledge and skills for each course.

# For Students Who Entered 9<sup>th</sup> Grade in 2018-2019 and Thereafter

- Students will be required to complete all United ISD graduation requirements as referenced in the Foundation High School program and must do so in the designated grade level. If extenuating circumstances exist to impede the course sequence as designated for students in 9th grade, the course **must be taken no later than the 10th grade.**
- All magnet plan courses and Early College plan courses must also be taken in the designated grade level according to their respective four year plans.
