Curriculum Director Report October 20, 2025

Report Cards

Illinois School report cards will be released on October 30th. I have included how summative designations are calculated. Below is an explanation on how some of the data is calculated.

ELA and Math Proficiency- Each subject area and grade level as a target score for the percentage of students that should be meeting. For example last year the target score for 11th grade ELA was 47.62% of the students would be proficient. In order to get all of the points for the summative designation score you had to be at that score or above.

ELA and Math Growth. As an example they put all the 4th grade students that scored a 750 in 3rd grade together. They then compare those students' scores in 4th grade, and they line them up in order from best to worst. The middle gets 50% and the best scores get 99% and the lowest gets 1%.

Chronic Absenteeism- It's the percentage of students who missed more than 10% of the days.

Climate Survey- Is the 5 Essential Survey that our students take. It is the percentage of students who did the survey. In order to get all the points you have to have greater than 95% of students take it.

Graduation Rate- For the Summative Designation it takes into account 4 year, 5 year and 6 year graduation rates. 60% of the score is 4 years, 30% is 5 years and 10% is 6 year graduation rate.

Non Summative Designation Terms

Post Secondary Enrollment- This data is from class of 2023

Remediation- This is from Community Colleges only.

Teacher Attendance- Is the percentage of teachers that missed less than 10 days.

Summative Designations

ISBE is conducting listening tours next month, about changes they are making to the Summative Designations. They plan on turning in the revisions to the Federal Government this Spring.
