

Accountability Ratings/Gold Performance Acknowledgements

Of Keller ISD's 32 assessed campuses, 23 earned ratings of "Exemplary" or "Recognized" according to accountability ratings by the Texas Education Agency (TEA). Overall, Keller ISD had nine "Exemplary" campuses, 14 "Recognized" campuses, and eight "Acceptable" campuses. As a district, Keller ISD received an "Acceptable" rating.

The Gold Performance Acknowledgment (GPA) system acknowledges districts and campuses for high performance on indicators other than those used to determine accountability ratings. There are 12 areas that districts can receive acknowledgments and 14 areas that campuses can receive acknowledgments. Keller ISD had 29 schools receive one or more Gold Performance Acknowledgments, and a total of 96 acknowledgments were awarded to our campuses.

Character Education Outstanding Student of the Month

The Keller ISD Community of Character program is structured to identify one character trait per month and integrate the character traits into curriculum through activities in individual classrooms to school-wide events.

Jared McMahon, a fifth-grader at Chisholm Trail Intermediate, is the KISD Community of Character Outstanding Student of the Month for the month of December. The character trait for December was Caring.

Based on a radio spot he heard about a family in need, Jared was able to ultimately raise \$5,637.97, all of which was given to a family in need in Keller.
