**Board Goals for 2023-2028**

- Goal 1\*:** The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Reading will increase from 49% to 60% by June 2024, 65% for 2024-2025, 70% for 2025-2026, 75% for 2026-2027, 80% for 2027-2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**
- Goal 2\*:** Increased overall student performance in mathematics to 85% Meets Standard by 2028. The percent of 3rd grade students that score meets grade level or above on STAAR Math will increase from 53% to 65% by June 2024, 70% for 2024-2025, 75% for 2025-2026, 80% for 2026-2027, 85% for 2027-2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**
- Goal 3\*:**The percentage of graduates that meet the criteria for CCMR will increase from 72% to 88% by August 2024 and increase to 95% by 2028. **(HB3 Required Goal)**

**Summary:** **The Texas Academic Performance Report (TAPR) is published annually and includes student performance on the state STAAR assessment, disaggregated by various student groups. Statute requires that each school district's Board of Trustees must hold a public hearing to discuss the district's annual Texas Academic Performance Report (TAPR).**

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**Commissioner rule designates that this hearing for public discussion of the TAPR report must be held within 90 calendar days of the reports release, which was December 12, 2024. Within two weeks following the public hearing, each district must widely publish its annual report, including posting the report on the district website and providing copies in other public places.**

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**Background Information:** The Texas Academic Performance Reports (TAPR) pull together a wide range of information on the performance of students in each school and district in Texas every year. Performance is shown disaggregated by student groups, including ethnicity and socioeconomic status. The reports also provide extensive information on school and district staff, programs, and student demographics.
